Directions to Cedar Key Florida:

- Get off I-75 in Gainesville, Florida at Exit 384 and head west to Cedar Key. This is State Route #24.
- Take State Route #24 southwest for approximately 50 miles. You will cross over State Highway 27/41 in Archer, Alternate 27 in Bronson, and US 19/98 in Otter Creek. *(Yes, it's quite deserted.)*
- Keep driving past the Cedar Key Scrub State Reserve. (This is a nice two or three hour trip if you have the time!) You'll come to a series of bridges to get out to the island - open your windows and inhale, you're almost there!
- Continue until you encounter a stop sign in the village of Cedar Key.
- At the stop sign, (Second Street) turn left and follow Second Street to the very end past the Cedar Key Beach. *(Yes, the directions are this simple.)*
- Second Street dead-ends into two driveways, take the left fork into Old Fenimore Mill Condominiums. You've arrived! The rental office (for picking up keys) is the first building on your right.
